- 6) Work with other uses to ensure ongoing dialogue ad constructive project partnering;
- 7) We will work together to encourage other uses access to trails;
- 8) We will work together to find ways to increase trails, mixed, shared or single use in the areas where we interact;

- 9) Share resources such as, maps, event planning, social media, and other communications so that we are all well informed about one another.
- 10) Meet regularly through Regional Trail Committees or Councils to discuss our shared trail environments.
